Main purpose of the job:

A Leak Detection Engineer is responsible for carrying out day to day leak detection activities in order to meet our targets defined.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities

- Check instructions for surveys on a daily basis and receive updates regularly .
- To maintain Leak detection equipment using the proper operation conditions as directed including cleaning of cases and company vehicle.
- Set up and breakdown equipment after each survey.
- Responsible for all work related activities and adherence to health and safety policy and procedures.
- Adequate and accurate completion of all paperwork - detailed reports to identify the type and location of the leak. Completing each report after each job.
- Good customer relations by presenting yourself in a professional manner ensuring work areas are safe and in line with procedures and the health and safety policy.
- Communicating with administrating staff to ensure surveys run smoothly.
- Assist repair teams by providing leak detection services.
- To have the ability to act upon own initiative to solve and overcome problems/issues.
- Promote a high quality Customer Service culture with timely responses to all contacts, liaising regularly with engineers and the office to ensure customer standards are upheld.
- Provide assistance where required in the effective management of Leak Detection.
- Undertake such other duties as may be required to carry out work including interchanging duties with other staff.

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Additional responsibilities:

To undertake survey work/project work not normally associated with day to day leak detection. Sensitive to the requirements of the client in understanding the schedule is different and inconsistent. Completion of inventories, mileage charts and any other admin work required.

Measurable outputs:

To be 95% in accuracy in locating leaks.

Reports to be completed daily 100%

Decision making authority:

Authorised for 3 size N Cylinders of gas at one time. Authorisation required for larger jobs.

Budgetary authority:

To use equipment such as gas and materials wisely reusing as required for gas connection adhering to health and safety standards at all times.

Practical requirements:

Be prepared to work at designated times such as weekends if required with either days off in lieu or bonus depending on volume of work. Travel across region.

Training:

Training will be given however knowledge and experience would be an advantage over other applicants.

Job Location

The applicant must be prepared to travel within their County and further depending on demand.
